Please note that all NMIN researchers and trainees are expected to follow these guidelines.

AFFILIATION

Including an NMIN affiliation in your credentials as an author: if you are an NMIN-funded investigator and you have signed the NMIN Network Agreement, when publishing findings from an NMIN-supported project, please include "NanoMedicines Innovation Network (NMIN)" as an affiliation, following your name and university association.

ATTRIBUTION

In disseminating NMIN-funded research and related information about the Network, it is important that NMIN's contribution be appropriately recognized. Recognition heightens awareness of the Network, its people and activities. It also generates opportunities for collaboration in related ventures and enhances the potential for dissemination, use and commercial exploitation of Network research.

Recommended citations to facilitate your acknowledgment of NMIN support

Short version

Long version

Simple logo – for use in situations where the wordmark would not be readable or reproducible due to size or media constraints (i.e., page folios, die cuts, production of novelty items/giveaways etc.).


Reverse (white) logo with bilingual wordmark – for use on materials or in contexts with dark backgrounds.
